GARBO'S GARDEN

Since the 1950s, when it was the first hotel to grace the Caribbean island of St Barths, Eden Rock has been a destination for glamorous jet-setters that included Howard Hughes and Greta Garbo, for whom two of its suites are now named. Today, the hotel's design combines nostalgia for '50s opulence and a contemporary rock 'n' roll sensibility – the Villa Rockstar incorporates a full recording studio that includes the console used by John Lennon to record "Imagine." Another lavish villa houses a private art gallery exhibiting original paintings, lithographs and photographs. Beyond the hotel, guests can explore the island aboard one of the hotel's Mini Coopers or a BMW convertible, take to the sea in a luxury boat, or just relax on the pink-white sand, while being pampered by the staff with drinks and treats.
